
- PPT

OBS

- OBS is a very powerful and useful tool that support you to record your PPT, your voice, and even your camera stream.
- OBS (<https://obsproject.com/>) is open-source and free.
- It supports Windows, Mac, and Linux

- Download, install, and open it. You will find a screen like the figure in the next page

- Input source:
 - Audio input capture: your voice
 - Video Capture Device: your camera stream
 - Window Capture: Select PPT
 - You may need to configure PPT Slide Show to fill the screen when you record.
